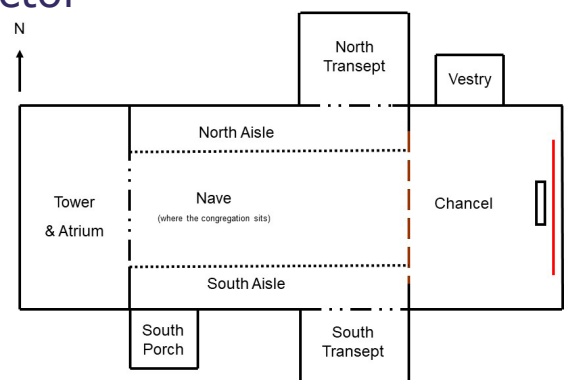

## Sending samples for DNA analysis

You can collect up to three samples of droppings per church. A new accumulation of droppings is a new sample and a new vial, pair of gloves and lolly stick should be used. Before returning the equipment, place the sealed vials in the envelope provided and write the location in the church where the droppings were collected.

## Checklist for placement of the bat detector

- Place in the Chancel
- The detector should be at a 45° angle
- The microphone should be pointing towards the body of the church
- Leave for two nights (or for one night if two is not possible)
