

VBRV – level one (WML-CL15)

Registered person and their assistants can:

- Disturb bats (all species), and
- Take and/or capture bats (all species)
 - **but not hibernating bats**
- By means of:
 - Artificial light (e.g. torches)
 - Endoscopes
 - Hand
 - Static hand-held nets
- While undertaking official duties as a VBRV

VBRV – level two (WML-CL16)

- Everything under level one
- Plus
- To train bat workers for the purposes of volunteer bat roost visitor activities



Bat Conservation Trust 

Survey licence - level one (WML-CL17)

Registered person and their Assistants can:

- **Disturb** bats (all species) and
- Use artificial light (e.g. in the form of a torch but not an endoscope)

Does **not** include:

- Handling
- Disturbance of hibernating bats

Survey licence - level two (WML-CL18)

Registered Persons, their Accredited Agents and Assistants can:

- Do everything as under level one
- Plus use:
 - Endoscopes;
 - Hand; and
 - Static hand-held nets
- Allows disturbance **but not** handling of hibernating bats

Survey licence - level three (WML-CL19)

Registered Persons, their Accredited Agents and Assistants can:

- Do everything as under level two

Registered person only can:

- Take and/or capture bats (all species) by means of:
 - Mist nets; and Acoustic lures
 - **For commissioned development purposes, max. 3 days at any one site, and by registered persons only**

Survey licence - level four (WML-CL20)

Registered Persons, their Accredited Agents and Assistants can:

- Do everything as under level two

Registered person only can:

- Take and/or capture bats (all species) by means of:
 - Harp traps; and Acoustic lures
 - **For commissioned development purposes, max. 3 days at any one site, and by registered persons only**
