The Bat Conservation Trust is looking to contract an Amazon Web Services specialist

The Bat Conservation Trust (BCT) oversees a suite of bat monitoring surveys in which participants use acoustic sensors to make sound recordings of bats. These recordings are uploaded to a sound classification system hosted on Amazon Web Services, which uses a series of machine-learning algorithms to automatically classify the recorded sounds to species. We require an AWS specialist, either an individual or organisation, to suggest and implement improvements to this system. We have a high-level design of the proposed work, but the exact improvements will be developed in discussion with the appointed contractor and our advisors. These are anticipated to include:

- Transfer of an online image-tagging tool, scripted in Python, from its current location on a local server to our AWS space.
- Move infrastructure from a containerization to EC2-based design.
- Implement project instance creation using Terraform or similar infrastructure as a code tool.
- Implement job initialization using a Lambda function or Fargate, TBC
- Implement a Simple Queue Service for job queues with event-based job creation
- Implement use of GitHub for version control
- Put in place spot bidding for resources.
- Move databases to an Aurora serverless service
- Incorporate a shared data lake using Athena for archived project data.
- Advise on a data lifetime policy

Timescales:

Work to be initiated as soon as possible and ideally completed by March 2022. Following the successful completion of the tasks listed above we would look to call upon your services to further improve and maintain our AWS infrastructure going forward.
