



# Make your own bat donation collector

## What you will need:

- \* 2 x A4 Black card
- \* Stapler
- \* Sticky tape
- \* White gel pen
- \* String



- Make a cone shape with a sheet of A4 card using roughly half the page. Add sticky tape/staple it together and cut off the other side.
- Cut off the top the cone in a arched semi-circle to create the bats head and ears.
- Using the other piece of card. Fold it in half and draw a bat wing. Cut out the shape.
- Staple the wings onto the cone shape. Using a hole punch created two holes at the back of the cone and thread through the string.
- Draw on some eyes and fangs, hang your bat up ready to be filled with your donations.



*If you are a child remember to only use scissors if you are supervised by a responsible adult*
